This is to advise of the following Direction of Madam Prothonotary Ayles dated December 5, 2017:

“Further to the case management conference held December 5, 2017, the following timetable shall apply to the Applicant’s motion to compel answers to questions objected to by the FNI pursuant to written cross-examinations:
