

Are you, or was a family member,
a participant in the Salaried Pension Plan provided by
Brewers Retail Inc (“BRI”)?

BRI Salaried Pension Plan Class Proceeding

This Notice is directed: (i) to all persons who were employed by BRI at any time between January 1, 1974 and December 31, 2009, and who were entitled to receive benefits from the BRI Salaried Pension Plan, and who did not receive an indexed pension; and (ii) to all persons who are a beneficiary of such an employee, if deceased (collectively, “Class Members”).

**This Notice does not apply to participants in any other pension plan provided by BRI.*

The Ontario Superior Court has certified the BRI Salaried Pension Plan Class Proceeding and will hold a hearing in Toronto on June 17, 2024 to consider approving a proposed settlement (the “Settlement”) for the benefit of the Class Members.

If you are a Class Member, you have the right:

- to do nothing. You will participate in the Settlement if it is approved;
OR
- to object to the Settlement. You will still participate in the Settlement if it is approved;
OR
- to opt out of the Class Proceeding (thereby choosing not to receive certain benefits from the Settlement, if approved).
